



The Board of Governors announces the search for the next president of Ambrose University College. The Search Committee of the Board invites nominations, expressions of interest and applications for the position of President.

Ambrose University College is located in Calgary, Alberta and is the denominational school of The Christian and Missionary Alliance in Canada and The Church of the Nazarene Canada. Its programs are accredited by the Association for Biblical Higher Education, the Association of Theological Schools, and the Province of Alberta. Ambrose offers eleven degree programs at the undergraduate level in arts and science and eight ministry degrees. At the seminary, five masters' degrees are offered with online delivery options available; two of the programs are also taught in Chinese. Currently, Ambrose has over 700 students enrolled.

The new Ambrose President will have the ability to clearly and energetically articulate the mission and vision of Ambrose, effectively and enthusiastically represent its theological traditions, and be a strategic thinker and leader in higher education, cognizant of educational issues and public policies, able to provide positive, inspiring and visionary leadership that encourages creativity and innovation.
